# 01 ABOUT US





The ancient imperial city attracts many tourists every year and Rabat was named capital of Arab youth for the year 2016 by the Council of Arab Ministers of Youth. Living in Morocco will be your perfect chance to study and learn the Moroccan dialect and also to practice foreign languages, such as English, French and Spanish with Moroccans and foreigners that live there. Studying in Ahlan School will also be a great opportunity to meet other people and organize activities.

# WHY MOROCCO

The locals really appreciate those who try to communicate in Arabic, whether in Fusha or Darija. # COURSES

## WHAT TO EXPECT

### Ahlan World Morocco

offers courses for Arabic students of **all levels - including complete beginners.**

Our teachers are professionals, highly qualified and experienced in teaching non-native speakers.

**Group courses** generally have 2-8 students, allowing for tailored instruction and personal attention.

If a student enrolled in one of our group courses and is **the only one in their level**, we will arrange **one-to-one classes instead of group classes.** In this case, the number of hours per week for each course will be as follows:

**MSA – 10 hours**

**MSA intensive – 17,5 hours**

**MCA – 7,5 hours**

Ahlan World's teaching methods are based on the principle that foreign language enables communication in **everyday situations**, and that practice is essential to master new skills. The learning process at Ahlan World, therefore, includes **role-plays, group discussions, and games on a daily basis**, as well as the **incorporation of media, literature, poetry, movies and songs** that encourage regular practice of new vocabulary and improvement in comprehension skills.

# MSA COURSES

IN A GROUP

## MODERN STANDARD ARABIC

MSA

**MSA courses** give students the **linguistic essentials** of the Arabic language, with a focus on the foundations of its structure, grammar rules, and key vocabulary. MSA is primarily used in **Arabic media, academic texts, religious scripts, literature and in formal settings**, rather than on the streets and in everyday conversations.

Nonetheless, most Arabs understand and use MSA, regardless of where they are from or which dialect they speak. MSA is most closely related to the **classic, original form of the Arabic language** upon which the many different **dialects were initially based and formed**.

*MSA courses consist of 2 hours per day, 5 days per week.*

**MSA intensive course** encompasses all of the material in the standard MSA course listed above, but with an **additional** focus on vocabulary and grammar specifics, comprehension activities, games that test various linguistic skills, and conversation practice. The intensive course is **one of the best options** for those students wishing to make the most out of their time in Morocco.

*Intensive MSA courses consist of 4 hours per day, 5 days per week.*

# MCA COURSES

IN A GROUP

## MOROCCAN COLLOQUIAL ARABIC

MCA

**MCA** courses offer students an immersive study of the Moroccan dialect, which is used by **locals for everyday interactions and conversation**. The course in Moroccan Colloquial Arabic consists of two hours daily from Monday to Friday. This course can be combined with the standard MSA courses, but not the intensive MSA course.

Study of MCA dialect focuses more on the essentials of navigating **life in an Arab country**, including important vocabulary, phrases, and sayings that students may **hear daily** while living abroad.

***MCA courses consist of 2 hours per day, 5 days per week.***

# OTHER COURSES



## AHLAN LINGUISTIC PACKAGE

MSA + MCA

**The Ahlan Linguist Package** combines the advanced linguistic study and universalism of **Modern Standard Arabic (MSA)**, with specific knowledge of the **Moroccan colloquial arabic (MCA)**, providing students with a **comprehensive understanding** of the Arabic language and its varied uses.

Students in the course will gain **unique proficiency** in the language as well as flexibility regarding future study, as they will have experience in both **MSA and MCA dialect**.

*Ahlan Linguist Package consists of 2 hours per day MSA classes plus 2 hours per day MCA dialect classes, 5 days per week.*


**One-to-one classes** are also available all year-round, **both on-site and online.** These classes are held at a time that best suits the student and according to teacher availability.

# SPECIAL PROGRAM

**Ahlan world** runs classes **all year round** in different cities at the same time. Therefore, if a student chooses a program of **longer than six weeks**, he/she can move, at any time, between **Alexandria, Cairo, Rabat or Amman**. This special offer allows you to change cities and explore **new experiences** while still following the Arabic study program!

Students enrolled in **one-to-one** or **small group classes (two-to-one and three-to-one)** can schedule classes at a time that suits them (between Monday/Sunday and Thursday/Friday, from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm), but timing will also depend on teacher availability. If students have specific time preferences.





# CLASS HOURS

## GROUP COURSES

**Standard lessons are held five days per week, Monday to Friday. Class hours are:**

- **MSA:** 2 hours (9:00am - 11:00pm)
- **MSA Intensive:** 4 hours (9:00am - 11:00pm) and (12:00pm - 2:00pm)
- **MCA:** 2 hours (1:00pm - 3:00 pm)

**Please note:** If a student enrolled on one of our group courses is the only one in their level, we will arrange one-to-one classes, equivalent in material and price but shorter in time.

## ONE-TO-ONE CLASS HOURS

Students enrolled in **one-to-one or small group classes** can schedule classes at a time that suits them (Monday to Friday, from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm), depending on teacher availability. If students have specific time preferences, they must be specified **during registration** or at least **two weeks before courses begin**. If preferences are not expressed ahead of time, Ahlan World will select the class times.

## AFTER AND IN-BETWEEN CLASSES

Students are welcome to spend time in Ahlan World's common room during breaks and after class. Tea is provided during the breaks. Students will also find a wide collection of Arabic books that can be borrowed from school's library.

## LEVEL TEST

**Prior to your arrival**, we ask students to take our online MSA level test, leaving as much time as is possible before your course start date, after which we will schedule an oral level test (online). MCA level tests are also carried out online.

Once we have received your test results for both, we are able to plan ahead and schedule your classes accordingly. **Absolute beginners need not** complete either placement test before their first lesson.

# HOW DO I REGISTER?

After receiving **your application** via email, we will send you an **invoice** detailing all services to be provided and their related costs. Payment must be made **by the date** indicated in the contract.

## HOW DO I PAY?

- Payment can be made **online via bank transfer or PayPal, or in-person at Ahlan World Morocco “cash”**.

***Please note: bank transfer fees will be paid by the sender.***

- Relevant procedures and information for paying online will be included in the **invoice**.
- Students are required to pay for the invoice at **least two weeks prior to arrival** (if not agreed otherwise).
- Should a student wish to **add private classes or courses** following initial registration, this **can be done and paid for in Morocco** (online payment is available too).
- Prospective students who are already in Rabat can come **directly** to the centre to enroll or inquire about courses.



# FINAL CERTIFICATE

Course examinations are held **every two weeks**, and a course certificate will be given to each student on **their last day**. The certificate will show the **number of class hours attended, the level and type of course, and the final evaluation of progress.**

**The final evaluation will be determined as follows:**

**60% for your final exam**  
**40% for the mid-course exam**  
**attendance**  
**class participation**

If a student cannot attend the final day, arrangements will be made to send the certificate by e-mail.

For special classes or seminars, the certificate will be signed by Ahlan world, and any partner organizations involved. Many universities will award credits for courses taken at Ahlan World, although it is each student's responsibility to confirm their universities policies and requirements **before registration** to ensure expectations are met.

### **Ahlan is accredited officially by CIMA**

# EXTRACURRICULAR 05 ACTIVITIES



Apart from teaching Arabic, the Ahlan Institute encourages its students to converse with native Arabic speakers outside of the classroom. Its **evening and weekend cultural activities**, as well as **language and cultural exchanges** with Moroccan students (TANDEM), are very popular and encourage students to practice the Arabic they have learnt.

Ahlan Morocco organizes trips for students. You can also travel by yourself although it will cost more or at least as much as going with the group and may have some other complications. Of course, this applies to some places and not all of Morocco: there are cities you can go visit yourself and others that are best visited with the school. You can suggest some cities and places to the staff and they will try their best to make it happen. The **most popular trips** are **Chefchaouen/Akchour** and **Merzouga Desert**.

The prices differ depending on the number of students going; the fewer the students, the higher the prices.

Morocco has **cheaper cost of living** than European Countries. Of course, there are places that are cheaper than others, though if you want high quality products, sometimes it can cost a bit. This is valid for trips as well as consumption in general when you go out to restaurants or clubs.

The trips are the best part of our activities, Ahlan organizes trips to:

**Merzouga** (the desert) 3 days, 2 nights, and you sleep in beautiful hotels but also Bivouacs, camel ride, safari jeep and full board.

**Marrakesh tour** 2 days

**Meknes** 1 day .



# 06 ACCOMMODATION

## WHAT TYPES OF ACCOMMODATION ARE AVAILABLE?

Ahlan World Morocco is pleased to offer students the option to stay in an apartment share arranged by the school.

All accommodation is close to the school in the most popular area in Rabat, close to the city centre.

Apartments are fully furnished, equipped with kitchen facilities, and have **Wi-Fi** (password will be found posted on the wall in each apartment).

# APARTMENTS



Our basic accommodation is less expensive than equivalent accommodation in Europe and is located centrally in Rabat. **All utility / costs are included**, excluding tips for the local staff. The apartments are usually mixed-gender but double rooms are allocated on a female/male basis. For further information on alternative apartments (whether more luxurious or less) **please contact us directly.**

Note: since the check-in for the accommodation is 2 days before the start of the course and the checkout is 1 day after the end of the course, if you will need to stay for additional days, you will be charged 21 \$ per night if you're staying in single room and 15 \$ per night if you're staying in double room (subject to availability).

**Check-in: Saturday after 6 pm, Check-out: Saturday before 11 am.**

The available apartments are roughly middle-class and the cost of rental is dependent on the number of rooms in an apartment. Therefore, a **single room costs 364 \$ monthly** and a **shared double room costs 193 \$ per person.**

Private apartments are also available; contact us to receive more information about the fees.

## APARTMENT PRICES

Single room: 640 USD monthly (160 USD per week)

Double room: 520 USD per person monthly (130 USD per week).

**NOTE: The apartments are usually mixed gender, but shared rooms are allocated on a male/female basis.**

**In the prices above, all bills are included (Internet, Gas, Water, Electricity)**

# HOST FAMILIES

Ahlan World Morocco is also able to offer a limited number of carefully selected family. This is a great opportunity for students to **practice Arabic** outside of the classroom and immerse themselves in the culture. Students in family stays may also have **the option of dinner, included**. Ahlan World will provide students with specific information regarding their family-stay location about a **week before arrival**. Students will receive their host family's contact information.

We also have a limited number of double (shared) rooms available for students (female) **who book together** and would like to choose the family-stay option.

# USEFUL 07 INFORMATION

## WHAT TO PACK?

**In the summer,** the climate is warm and humid. There is some relief provided by the relative proximity of the sea, but you should plan for warm/hot weather.

**In the winter,** it is quite cold and windy. There are no centralised heating systems, so we advise you to bring warm, winter clothes for use inside your accommodation. The city of Rabat is generally frequented by European tourists and the inhabitants are therefore accustomed to some of the casual or revealing styles more popular in the West.

We ask that you do your best to **show respect for the local population**, and considering the possibility of offense in their interactions with European women, please do not bring/wear low-necked blouses or dresses, miniskirts, halter tops, or any other garment that will leave your mid-section exposed!

**Important note: The institute and its associates cannot be held responsible for any problems that may arise from not following the advice given above.**

# TRAVEL 08

## HOW TO GET TO RABAT?

A lot of International airlines fly direct to Casablanca: Royal Air Maroc, Air France, Iberia, Alitalia, Air Arabia, British Airways and Lufthansa, Easyjet, Transavia.



## AHLAN AIRPORT TRANSFERS AND COSTS:

If requested, Ahlan representative will meet students at the scheduled arrival time in Rabat and transport them to their accommodation.

He will be carrying a sign with “Ahlan Morocco” and the name of the student written on it. **The driver will wait in the Arrival Terminal**, after passport control.

### The prices for the transfers:

Rabat-Salé 32 \$ | Casablanca-Rabat 85 \$ | Fes-Rabat 85 \$ | Marrakech 100 \$

**Note: Trains and Buses are also available, choose the best option for you and organize with us accordingly.**

Taxis at the airport should have fixed prices – the **average is 20 \$** (MAD 250) but taxi drivers often try to fool foreigners and ask for much more than what should be paid, or may tell you a price at the beginning and then change it along the way with excuses, such as “There is a lot of traffic today, you have to pay me more”, so **be careful** if you decide to get a cab from the airport. Buses also connect the Rabat airport to the train station of the city

**Note: If you do not book an airport transfer, the first bus from Salé-Rabat airport is at 8.00 AM and the last one is at 10.00 PM. If you choose this option please contact us before and one of us can pick you up in Rabat Ville (Train Station or Bus stop), escort you to your flat, and give you the keys.**

# DOCUMENTS

**You will need to contact your country's consulate or embassy to get precise information about the required documentation for your trip.**

Generally, you will need your **passport** and a **visa** that you can obtain at the airport when you arrive in Morocco.

When asked to fill in the motivation for your trip to Morocco, you must write down **"Tourism"**.

**This visa remains valid for 3 months. .**



When asked for an address, please provide the address of your apartment. Keep in mind that visas may be required to visit other countries in the region. Before your departure always check your local authority for more information

# UTILITIES



## PLUGS AND ELECTRICITY

The electrical voltage in Egypt is **220V**. Most outlets take **two-pin plugs**, although some take three. Adapters are easy to find if needed.

## INTERNET



**Free Wi-Fi** can be found at the school and the library is provided with WI-FI as well. There are also plenty of cafés in Rabat.

Most of the cafés in the Rabat city centre have free Wi-Fi.

**If needed, personal Wi-Fi connections**, you can purchase a SIM card with data package according to your preferences.

## TELEPHONE SERVICE



Cell phones are convenient and practical because it is possible to text messages (contact your provider first to confirm service and pricing), but the cost of calls will be based on both the call and the response.

### **To telephone from Morocco:**

It can be very useful to buy a Moroccan number during your stay. SIM cards can be purchased at the Inui, Orange or Maroc Télécom centers in Rabat, or in one of the many phone shops around the city. The price of a SIM card is MAD 20 . If you have a smart phone you can also purchase a data package starting from MAD 5 for 1 GB for 3 days (depending on promotions from different companies).

# EATING OUT

**Typical Moroccan food** costs from € 2,50 to € 10,00 in sit-down restaurants. Dinner can range from € 8,00 to € 15,00 **according to the type of restaurant.**

“Western style” cafes and restaurants with imported food and beverages are particularly expensive.

Alternatively, cheaper lunch and dinner options including pastries and sandwiches can be found for less than MAD 20.


**In general, you can find many different types and styles of restaurants.**

**Groceries** can be purchased at small grocery stores found in every neighbourhood or at larger supermarkets such as Carrefour and Marjane.

**Fruits and vegetable** can be found in both markets and large supermarkets and offer the largest variety of goods. Prices for groceries also vary depending on the vendor but can be cheaper to those found in many western countries.



# TRANSPORTATION



**There are 2 types of Taxis:**

**Blue Taxi.** It has a meter inside (counter). Always remember to ask the driver to turn the meter on as soon as you get inside the taxi if he hasn't done so.

**The “Big Taxi”,** which is **white**, is meant for longer rides and the fee is MAD 5. The basic fee for shared taxis is MAD 6.



**Public Buses** cost MAD 5. The tramway costs MAD 6.

**The tramway** is also a very popular transportation in Rabat, costs MAD 6. It has 2 lines, check them from [here](#).

# 10 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## ENROLLMENT


**Bookings** must be made by either emailing the school at [rabat@ahlan-world.org](mailto:rabat@ahlan-world.org) or by completing the **online application** on the school's **website**.

The school reserves the right to refuse admission to any student at the absolute discretion of the school management. If a booking is refused, all fees will be refunded.

## FEES

All fees for **on-site classes** must be received, in full, **two weeks before the course and/or accommodation start date**. If fees are not received by this time, the course/accommodation will be **cancelled**. It is not possible for a student to start a course or be accommodated if fees have not been received by the school.

All online courses must be paid **one week prior** to commencement.



## PHOTOGRAPH / FILM / MEDIA

At times the school **may photograph or film students** in various activity settings or may make use of such photographs and/or films made by students, for **marketing or promotional purposes**. A signed consent form must be completed with your e-Booking registration documents.

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS



## LIABILITY

**The school does not accept liability** for injury, illness, accident, damage to or loss of property and/ or personal effects, except when such liability is imposed under Moroccan law. **We strongly recommend students ensure they have appropriate, travel, medical, and personal-property insurance.**

## FORCE MAJEURE

**The school is not liable** for any failure to perform its duties as a result of events **beyond the schools** reasonable control such as fire, flood, war, acts of terrorism, storms, the outbreak of infectious diseases, government sanction and other instances that constitute force majeure. **In such instances no refunds can be made for services not received nor for any that are cancelled.**

**Ahlan World is closed on certain [public holidays](#).** Students are advised to check the country-appropriate course calendar and plan accordingly.

# CLASS CANCELLATION POLICY

For **one-to-one classes (including online courses)**, if you cannot attend a private class and want to have it rescheduled, please inform the school **by 4pm one business day before** (e.g., should you wish to cancel a class scheduled for Monday, your notification should be given by 4pm the preceding Friday). Failure to give the requested notice will prevent us from being able to reschedule the class as requested, and it will therefore be **cancelled**, without a refund, instead.

**Online classes/ package** must be paid, in full, **one week before commencement**. All **on-site classes** must be paid, in full, **2 weeks before commencement**.

**Should you cancel the course, there will a 10% cancellation fee.**

For long term students taking a **small-group course** (two-to-one/three-to-one). **The school cannot reschedule any group class unless the entire group agrees.** In this case, the same cancellation notification policy detailed above applies.

For MCA and MSA daily group courses, **we cannot reschedule or refund individual lessons** within the group MSA/MCA daily course.

If you are **more than 15 minutes late** to a class, the teacher will be permitted to cancel the class and you will **not be refunded**.

**The following percentages of the total price of the package will be charged to the student, in case of cancellation, based on the number of days prior to the scheduled date of the booked course** (the exact date of cancellation will be considered to be the first day after receipt of the written notice):

- **Up to 41 days** prior to the starting course total of **registration fees** will be charged.
- **From 30 to 40 days** prior to the date of starting course **40%** of the total of the fees will be charged.
- **From 21 to 29 days** prior to the date of starting course **50%** of the total of the fees will be charged
- **From 15 to 20 days** prior to the date of starting course **70%** of the total of the fees will be charged
- **From 0 to 14 days** prior to the date of starting course **100%** of the total of the fees will be charged

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

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
